### The Science of Learning and Generative AI Professor Miriam Tanti

Generative AI is already changing how students access information, complete tasks and engage with learning. The challenge for schools is ensuring it supports learning, rather than replacing the thinking students need to do for themselves.

Professor Miriam Tanti from La Trobe University will draw on her recently released *The Science of Learning and Generative AI: A guide for secondary teachers* to explore how GenAI can strengthen rather than shortcut learning.

Miriam will consider the implications for practice, including attention and cognitive load, memory, problem-solving, and metacognition.



### The Conditions for School Improvement Vic Zbar

School improvement is rarely about finding the next new initiative. It is about creating the conditions for good practice to take hold and be sustained.

Vic Zbar's work on school improvement continues to hold up because it focuses on the fundamentals. In this session, Vic will revisit the enduring principles from his work and explore what they mean for school leaders now.
